UAD Knife Policy

This policy applies on location at all:

- processing plants,
- warehouses,
- shipping terminals, and
- production and drilling locations owned, operated, or leased by UA Deep Water.

It does not apply on marine vessels.

Other than for food preparation and dining:

- Use of knives is prohibited.
- Alternative cutting tools must be used. Examples include but are not limited to:
 - Spring-loaded safety box cutters
 - Craftsman Handi-cut Utility Cutter Set (2 1/2" and 3 7/8")
 - Craftsman No. 9 Side cutter pliers
 - Craftsman Electrical Repair Tool
 - Fiskars Multi-Snip
 - Raptor Safety Knife
 - EMT Scissors
 - Moving Edge Safety Knife
 - PVC Cutters 1" and 2" Ratchet Type
 - Blunt End Safety Knife (only for electricians, instrumentation/communication techs, medics/EMTs, and Rescue Team members)
